Privacy Notice

The British Inter-County Youth Darts League (Southern Section) is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. For any personal data you provide for the purposes of your membership under the General Data Protection Regulation 2018.

The British Inter-County Youth Darts League (Southern Section) is the Data Controller and is responsible for storing and otherwise processing that data in a fair, lawful, secure and transparent way.

The County Team that you register with by completion of the 'Player Registration Form' is the Data Processor.

What personal data we hold on you

You may give us information about you by filling in forms, or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register with The British Inter-County Youth Darts League (Southern Section) , The information you give us may include your name, date of birth, address, e-mail address, phone number, name of the affiliated Clubs with which you are registered and gender. We may also ask for relevant health information, other data which is classed as special category personal data.

Why we need your personal data

The reason we need your Data is to be able to administer your membership, and provide the membership services you are signing up to when you register with your County. Our lawful basis for processing your personal is that we have a contractual obligation to you as a member to provide the services you are registering for.

Reasons we need to process your data include:

For membership and County management

- processing of membership forms;
- sharing data with committee members to provide information about club activities, membership renewals or invitation to events;
- publishing of competition results

For competition entry

- sharing personal data with club team managers to enter events;
- sharing personal data with leagues, county associations and other competition providers for entry in events.

Any special category health data we hold on you is only processed for the purpose of fitness/health checks or passing health data to Team Managers or Officials to allow the safe running of matches and/or competitions. We process this information on the lawful basis of consent.

The British Inter-County Youth Darts League (Southern Section) has a Facebook account and occasionally uses other social media platforms which all members are free to join. If you join one of the Social Media pages, please ensure that the provider of the social media platform(s) have their own privacy policies and that The British Inter-County Youth Darts League (Southern Section) do not accept any responsibility or liability for these policies. Please check these policies before you submit any personal data on any social media pages.

Who we share your personal data with

The British Inter-County Youth Darts League (Southern Section) does not supply any personal data it holds to any other 3rd party without advising you. The British Inter-County Youth Darts League (Southern Section) data processing may require your personal data be transferred outside of the UK for the purpose of International Competitions and/or other events. Where The British Inter-County Youth Darts League (Southern Section) does transfer any data it is with the appropriate safeguards in place to ensure the security of that personal data.

How long we hold your personal data

Data is updated every year on annual membership forms. Any personal data we hold on you will be securely destroyed after two years of inactivity. Your data is not processed for any further purposes other than those detailed in this policy.

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you may have the right at any time to request access to, rectification or erasure of your personal data; to restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of your personal data, including direct marketing; to the portability of your personal data and to complain to the UK's data protection supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of your personal data.

As a data subject you are not obliged to share your personal data with The British Inter-County Youth Darts League (Southern Section). If you choose not to share your personal data with us we may not be able to register or administer your membership.
